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***THE ANALYSIS OF INFORMED CONSENT IN SECTIO CESAREATO INPATIENTS  
IN ANNA MEDIKA MADURA GENERAL HOSPITAL***

***ABSTRACT***

*A medical action consent form is needed to ensure that the patient understands all information needed to make a decision and the patient gives consent. In the preliminary study, observations were made on 5 sheets of consent forms, wherefrom the results of these observations it was found that from the 5 sheets of the form, each component was still incomplete. Components that have not been completed, such as No.RM, date of birth, and doctor's signature. The purpose of the study is to determine the completeness of the medical action approval form filling in the cesarean section for inpatients.*

*This type of research used a structured observation instrument checklist and interview guidelines. The population was 261 medical record documents, and the number of samples was calculated using the Slovin formula of 72 medical record documents. The sampling technique used was non-random simple, namely taking not randomly, the results of data collection using checklists and interviews. Analysis of the data used in this study was to use a descriptive quantitative analysis approach that was to produce a picture and analysis of a research result, but it was not used to make broad conclusions.*

*The results of this study on the completeness of the highest patient identity review on the item name as much as 97%. The completeness of the highest witness identity review on Item names was 100%. Completeness of the review of important reports on the action items obtained as much as 99%. Completeness of the highest authentication review on paramedic witness items was 97%. As for the incomplete data due to the inaccuracy of officers in filling out documents. If the action consent sheet is incomplete, it will cause information discontinuity and ownership of the contents of the informed consent.*

*Based on the conclusions of the results of this study, the suggestion for Anna Medika Madura General Hospital in improving discipline on all parties is given the importance of completeness in filling out medical record documents and conducting socialization for officers regarding procedures and rules in filling out medical action approval sheets.*
